

Alternative funding streams

We are aware of the following Government or ALB funding streams which youth organisations may be eligible for in addition to the universal HM Treasury schemes, such as the Coronavirus Job Retention Scheme and Business Interruption Loans. We would urge you to check the individual criteria as the eligibility will vary for each fund, and note that this list is unlikely to be exhaustive!

- [Sport England - £195m total funding package](#)
 - £20m Community Emergency Fund - £300-10k grants; to include voluntary and community sector organisations that deliver or enable sport and/or physical activity. **Open for bids**
 - £5m sector partner fund - aimed at Sport England's sector partners

- [Arts Council England - £165 total funding package](#)
 - £50m for organisations outside of Art Council England's National Portfolio (maximum award £35k)
 - Two rounds of funding; round 1 **closes 16th April**, round 2 **closes 30th April**
 - Focus is on publicly funded organisations delivering in the arts and cultural space.

- [BEIS - £20m Innovation Fund](#) - Adaption funding to support UK businesses to focus on emerging or increasing needs of society and industries during and following the Covid-19 pandemic. Grants of up to £50,000 **Closes 12pm 17th April**
